When A123 Systems, a company that makes lithium batteries for use in automobiles, filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy, employees worried about what this would mean in terms of their jobs.

On Tuesday October 16th, battery developer and manufacturer A123 Systems has voluntarily filed petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code in Delaware.

In August 2012, Chinese automotive components manufacturer Wanxiang Group agreed to invest up to \$465 million to acquire as much as 80% of A123 Systems; [27] but the acquisition was not completed ...

The agreement was reached following an auction conducted under the supervision of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware.

Bankrupt battery manufacturer A123 Systems has secured final approval from a bankruptcy court for the company's reorganisation plan.
