While a broken solar panel may seem like a lost cause, it's important to understand that it could still have some functionality left, depending on the extent of the damage.

Even if a solar cell has been damaged, that doesn't compromise the entire panel. Panel performance drops in proportion to the total amount of damage. For example, 10 to 20% of your solar ...

Minor damage to your PVs can be repaired, and that panel can go on to be used for the rest of its expected lifespan. However, if panels or glass are broken, you are better off replacing them.
