Under this proposal, homeowners would have until the end of 2025 to install and place their solar systems in service to qualify for the full 30% tax credit. This aggressive timeline represents ...

Not every setup qualifies, and the IRS is strict about timing. Your system has to be installed and running by December 31, 2025, not just ordered or sitting in your driveway.

In early July 2025, Congress voted to repeal the 30% federal tax credit for homeowners who install solar on their homes. The repeal takes effect January 1, 2026.

For example, roof trusses and traditional shingles that support solar panels don't qualify, but solar roofing tiles and solar shingles do because they generate clean energy.

President Donald Trump on Wednesday said his administration will not approve solar or wind power projects, even as electricity demand is outpacing the supply in some parts of the U.S.

The United States imports most of its solar panels, many of which come from China or factories in other Asian countries that China supports to avoid U.S. tariffs on Chinese solar panels.
