A solar panel with a pattern includes a substrate and an electricity generating layer. A patterned light-transmittable layer is coated on a face of the electricity generating layer.

Look closely at a solar panel, and you'll see a series of thin metallic lines running across the surface. They're not there to look nice -- they have a specific purpose.

Snail patterns (or snail trails) are those frustrating dark lines crisscrossing solar panels that resemble - you guessed it - snail tracks. They typically appear 6-18 months after installation and ...
