How much electricity does Zambia produce?

The Full Picture In total, Zambia currently has a grid and off-grid installed capacity of 3,777MW from generating assets owned by ZESCO and private developers, including independent power producers. This is how much electricity the country would produce if all its power plants, numbering at least 25, were to operate at their full capacity.

How is Zambia's Electricity Market structured?

Table 1: Installed and Available Generation Capacity (MW) Zambia's electricity market is structured as a single-buyer market model with ZESCO acting as the unique off-taker and bulk retailer of electricity on the national interconnected system.

What percentage of Zambians have access to the national power grid?

Only 43 percent of Zambians have access to the national power grid (67 percent of urban residents; and 14.5 percent of rural residents). ZESCO, a vertically integrated parastatal utility, operates government-owned power stations, and is responsible for maintaining and installing transmission lines and distribution networks.
